## **PLAYING REGULATIONS**

### **1. Date: October 30-31, 2009**

The Colts **Classic Girls High School Basketball Tournament** shall be held on the Friday and Saturday.

### **2. Location: Bill Crothers Secondary School. 44 Main Street Unionville, Ontario Canada L3R 2E4**

### **3. Tournament Structure and Procedures:**

- (a) The Colts **Classic** Championships shall be **modified elimination** tournaments with winners and losers moving to both sides of the draw. Winners of each side of the draw shall meet to determine

the Champion. Losers of the 3<sup>rd</sup> round games will go Consolation Championship Route.

- (b) Day 1 Tournament Schedule, no game shall start before 9:30 a.m. The final games shall be scheduled to start no later than 8:45 p.m. On Day Two of the Championship Schedule, no game shall start before 10:00 a.m. The final game shall be scheduled to start no later than 8:30 p.m.
- (c) Teams eliminated from Championship play after the second game will continue play in the "Consolation Round" which shall be a single elimination format.
- (e) Each team is guaranteed three games. No team shall play more than two (2) games on day one and no more than three (3) on day two
- (f) The following procedures shall take place at each game in the tournaments:
  - (i) At the beginning of each game each coach shall be given a sheet to choose the opposing teams MVP for that game. Sheets will be given to scorers table.
  - (ii) At the completion of the game players and coaches shall shake hands with all opponents.

## **6. Seeding:**

For the Colts **Classic** Championships, the entire draw shall be seeded by the Tournament Committee. Seeding will be based on that season's tournament results, and league records, and strength of schedule.

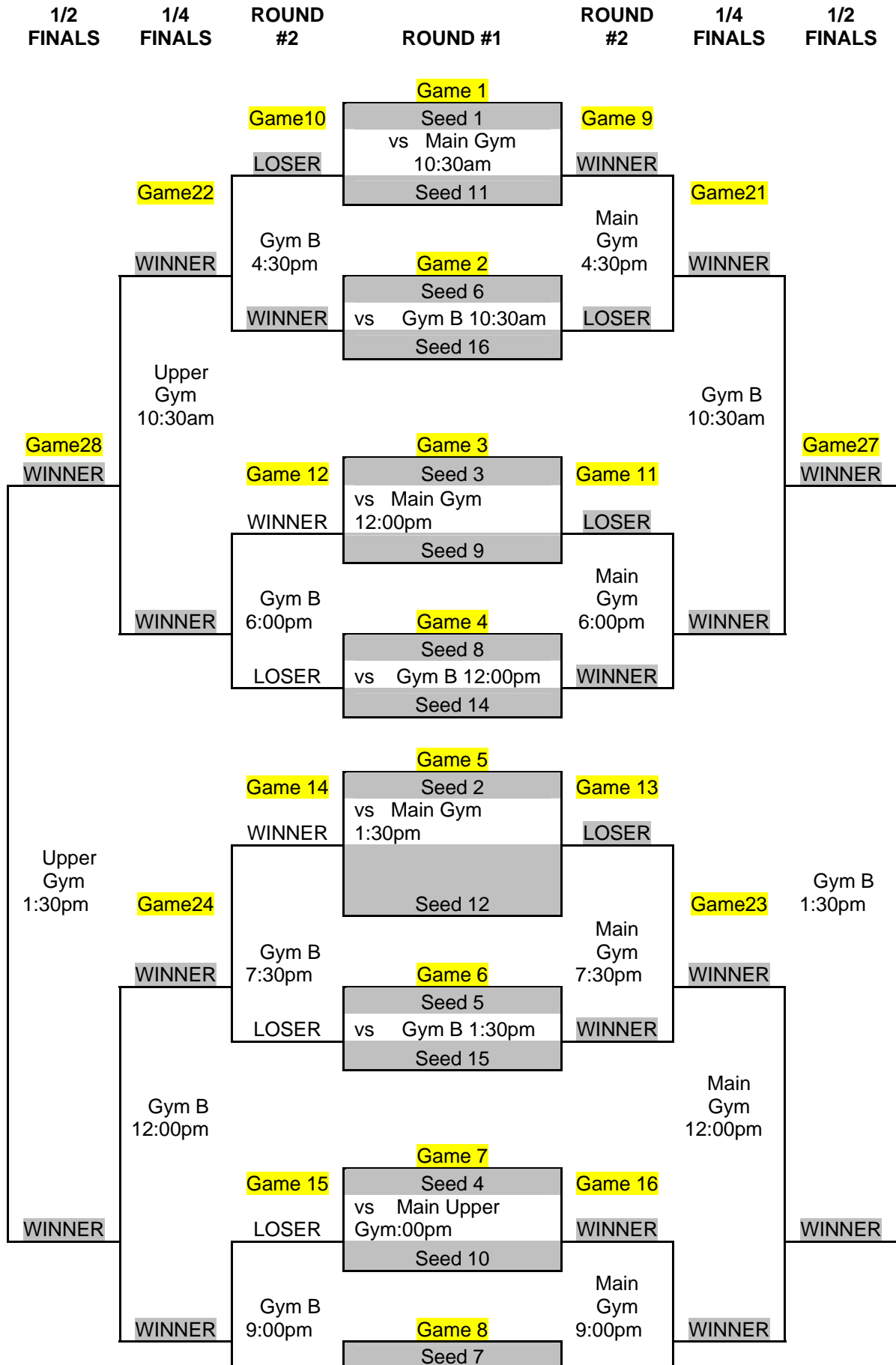

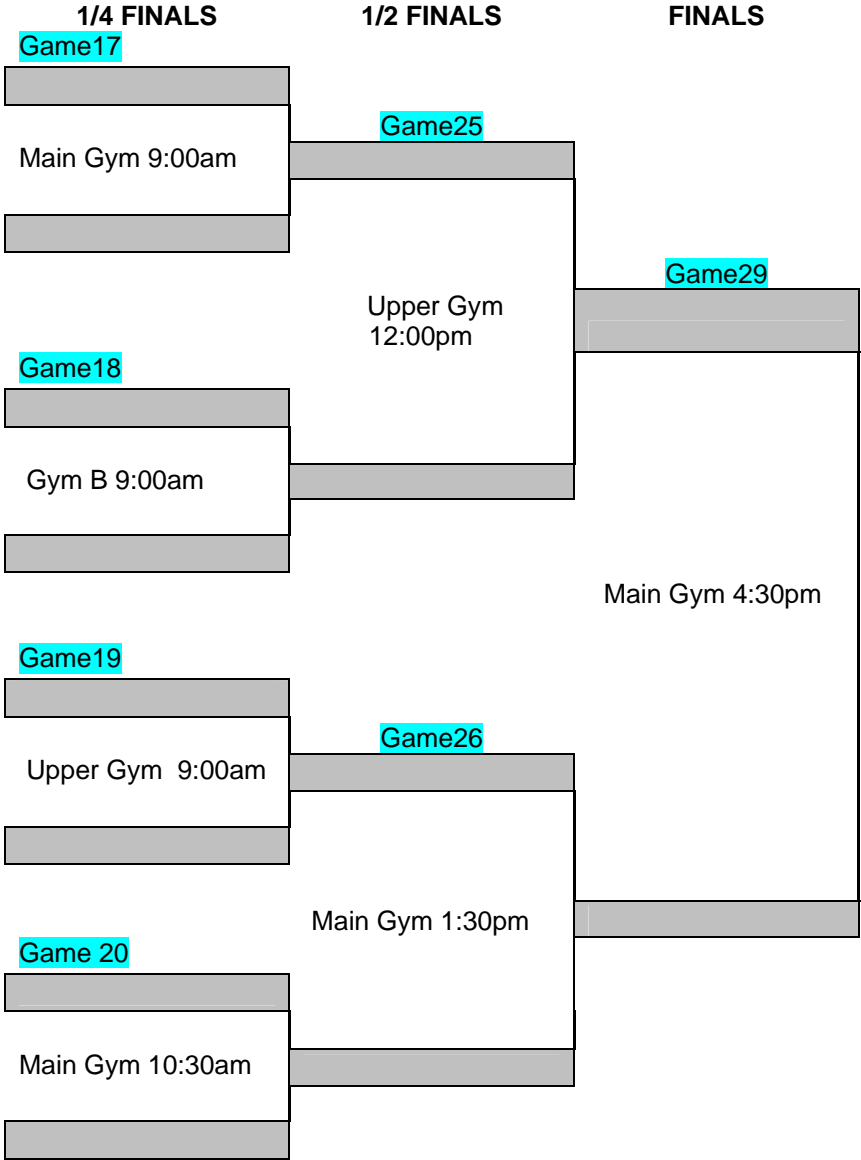

**8. Rules and Officials:**

The current National Federation Rule Book shall govern play at the Colts **Classic** Championships shall be officiated by two-person teams of officials.

Tournament Convenors shall be responsible for obtaining the best officials possible either through local Boards of Referees **or** through the Ontario Association of Basketball Officials as the Convenor's local circumstances dictate.

**9. Uniforms and Equipment:**

Uniforms shall be in accordance with the National Federation rules. Team players must wear identical colour shorts. Teams must provide a second set of uniforms or a set of legally-numbered markers of a different colour in case opponents have uniforms of a similar colour. A coin toss shall decide which team will change.

Game balls will be provided my Centennial College, but practice balls must be provided by each team.

**10. Awards:**

Championship teams shall receive Trophies (15) Members of the runner-up teams shall receive trophies (15). Teams will also be featured on Hoopstowngta.com

Members of the winning teams in the Consolation Championship will receive T-Shirts provided by Converse Canada and Advantage Basketball (15). Team will also be featured on Hoopstowngta.com

**11. Registration:**

Registration materials will only be given to the Coach/teacher accompanying the team.
